In addition, juniors are strongly encouraged to enroll in a Science course.</p> <p>Consult with your teachers, counselors, case managers, and the Program of Studies so as to determine which course level is most appropriate. Make sure you have met ALL requirements / prerequisites before signing up for a course. Obtain faculty signatures for only those courses that require a teacher recommendation.</p> <p>Lastly, remember to schedule courses that fulfill graduation requirements. Currently, MVHS requires 4 credits in mathematics unless the student has passed Algebra II. Students who successfully meet the competencies in Algebra II are only required to complete 3 credits in math. In these cases, the student would have to earn another elective credit so as to reach the cumulative 26-credit requirement.</small></p> | <p>Students who wish to participate in intercollegiate athletics at any Division I or Division II program must register with the NCAA Eligibility Center to ensure they have met certain requirements regarding the scope and rigor of their high school academic experience.
