Currently, MVHS requires 4 credits in mathematics unless the student has passed Algebra II. Students who successfully meet the competencies in Algebra II are only required to complete 3 credits in math. In these cases, the student would have to earn another elective credit so as to reach the cumulative 26-credit requirement.</small></p>	<p>Students who wish to participate in intercollegiate athletics at any Division I or Division II program must register with the NCAA Eligibility Center to ensure they have met certain requirements regarding the scope and rigor of their high school academic experience.
